

Skyscrapers (False) by Grant Fikes

Rules: Insert a number from 1 to N into each cell in the N by N grid so that no number repeats in any row or column. Also, each number in the grid represents the height of a building and the clues on the outside of the grid indicate how many buildings can be "seen" when looking from that direction. Taller buildings block the view of smaller buildings.

All exterior clues are false and should be either one higher or one lower than the value given.
